# The Redecclaration of Independence of We The People of the United States of America

The Solemn Declaration of The People of the United States of America,

From time immemorial, Tyranny has adorned itself and its intentions in many wonderful, magnificent, and beautiful garments. History has shown that these garments only serve to mask its true intentions, which are the total subjugation and the carrying into bondage of the very people it purports to be setting free. Whether it be a government wearing today's fashionable garments - Progressivism, Social Justice, Economic Justice, and The Green Economy - or the older, less fashionable and threadbare garments, Marxism, Communism, Socialism, Stalinism, Maoism, Elitism, or Statism, an exchange of one garment for another does not change the nature of the Tyrannical government, so clothed, stealthily lurking beneath.

The People of Our Great Nation stand at the crossroads of history, the great struggle for Liberty having been thrust upon them by a belligerently arrogant President and Congress, wearing the garments Progressivism, Social Justice, Economic Justice, and The Green Economy. The war between the forces of Tyranny and the forces of Liberty having already begun, it is certain that nothing can be of greater import, for the outcome of this epic struggle will affect, for better or for worse, our posterity for all time.

When a government fails to uphold its sworn duty to defend and protect the Unalienable Rights of its citizens,

When it seeks, at every turn, to undermine and destroy its citizens' Liberties,

When it seeks to drive its citizens into a perpetual state of bondage,

When it seeks to arbitrarily and fundamentally change the forms of government under which its citizens are governed without the consent of the governed,

It then becomes the responsibility, nay, the sacred duty, of these same citizens to not only forcefully make their voices heard, but to do all that which is necessary to defend and protect their Unalienable Rights, restore and preserve their Liberties, deliver themselves from bondage, defend and protect their forms of government, and implement safeguards to ensure their future security.

In the immortal words of Our Nation's Founding Fathers, found in our Declaration of Independence, we are instructed,

'We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain Unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness.

That to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed,

That whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new Government, laying its foundation on such principles and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their Safety and Happiness. Prudence, indeed, will dictate that Governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and accordingly all experience hath shown, that mankind are more disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed. But when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same Object evinces a design to reduce them under absolute Despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such Government, and to provide new Guards for their future security.’

These words ring no less true today than they did when first penned.

The history of this government for the past 100 years is a history of repeated injuries against its citizens and the exercise of power and privileges not granted to it by The People or the Constitution by which it is constrained. It is a period marked most noticeably by the enactment of unjust, oppressive, intrusive, and unconstitutional legislation, all of which having had the cumulative effect of eroding our Liberties, to such a degree, that their emaciated condition would cause that which remains to be scarce recognizable by Our Nation’s Founders. The actions of each successive President and Congress have become more egregious and onerous than the last. Corruption, cronyism, deceit, back door deals, bribery, lack of accountability, and moral degradation, along with a blatant disregard for the Constitution of the United States, have become the rule rather than the exception in this government. As if this were not enough, the acts of the present President of the United States and Congress are an overwhelming onslaught of unjust, oppressive, intrusive, unconstitutional and irresponsible legislation, Presidential Executive Orders, codes, taxes, and mandates, all having in direct object the establishment of an absolute Tyranny over the citizens of these United States of America. ‘To prove this, let Facts be submitted to a candid world.’

It has failed to honor its sworn duty to uphold and defend our Constitution, openly and publicly spurned our Constitution, declared our Constitution a “living document” open to broad interpretation and of no effect, and enacted laws that violate both the spirit and the letter of our Constitution.

It has plundered our treasury, borrowed vast sums of money, saddled our children with crushing debt, recklessly spent our nation into an impending state of bankruptcy, brought us to the brink of financial collapse, and destroyed the economic prosperity of our people.

It has foolishly spent The People’s money unwisely and extravagantly, rewarded itself and its supporters lavishly at the expense of the People, and failed to safeguard against fraud and theft.

It has made itself an enemy of capitalism, the free market system, and the fundamental principles which our nation is built on.

It has Taxed us without our consent, placed onerous financial burdens upon us, and ensnared us in a tangled and complex web of unintelligible tax laws and codes.

It has excited divisions amongst us by instigating class warfare, exacerbating racial tensions, and inciting hatred and animosity among people of differing opinions.

It has worked to stifle and eliminate free thought and free speech.

It has failed to secure our borders from foreign invaders, jihadists, and the traffickers of illicit drugs.

It has endeavored to prevent the rightful denial and policing of illegal immigration to these States; for that purpose obstructing or ignoring the Laws for Immigration and Naturalization of Foreigners; refusing to pass others to discourage their illegal migrations hither, and encouraging their migrations to these States by providing safe harbor, a broad range of free social services, and incentives to remain.

It has allowed Lobbyists and special interests to exert undue and disproportionate influence on legislation and the legislative process.

It has openly bribed legislators, created special exemptions for individual States, districts' and special interest groups, in violation of the citizens' right of equal protection under the law, in order to secure votes for unpopular legislation.

It has crafted legislation in secret behind closed doors, failed to provide for an open and honest dialogue, failed to provide for an adequate period of time to read and understand legislation brought to the floor for a vote, and selectively and arbitrarily barred legislators and the People from participation in the legislative process.

It has allowed the President to surround himself with an unprecedented number of persons with questionable loyalties, radical beliefs, and low moral character, resulting in the creation of a shadow government of "Czars"; an extra-governmental body filled with persons not approved by Congress and accountable only to the President.

It has approved to positions of leadership and policymaking unqualified persons lacking the experience, knowledge, and competence necessary to properly fulfill their duties, persons with low moral character, persons suspected or convicted of crimes, and persons with whose past or present actions and belief systems run counter to our own.

It has held its members of Congress, its supporters, and its closest allies above the law; it has protected its members of Congress, its supporters, and its closest allies, by mock investigations, from punishment for any crimes which they commit on the Inhabitants of these United States; and it has failed to indict, remove from committee(s) or office, those members of Congress who are suspected of committing serious crimes or improprieties.

It has failed to provide for our protection against enemy attacks on our homeland during a time of war.

It has alienated our allies, bowed before our enemies, retreated in the face of dangers, acted to diminish our security abroad, and conducted itself in a manner totally unworthy the representative of a free and sovereign nation.

It has abrogated its citizens' constitutional rights, subjecting the citizenry to foreign police powers.

It has created a multitude of bureaucracies, departments, and agencies, and sent swarms of agents, officers and government workers to harass the citizens into compliance.

It has taken over entire industries, coerced private businesses and citizens to act against their will, and seeks to devour and exert unwarrantable command and control over ever greater swaths of the private sector.

It has circumvented longstanding rules of Congress by means of tricks, devises, and the use of parliamentary procedures not intended for the purpose to which they have been used, in order to enact legislation that would not otherwise garner the necessary votes for enactment through the customary legislative process.

It has purposefully mislead The People on matters of national importance, lied openly and dissembled on matters both great and small, and attempted to render the issues so confused or opaque as to be difficult to perceive or understand, on occasions so numerous, as to have completely lost the trust and confidence of The People.

It has inserted itself into every aspect of the education of our youth, with the goal of indoctrinating, propagandizing, and subverting our children, against the will of the people.

It has worked to rewrite history, attempting to expunge from the record, the Truth of our Nation's religious heritage.

It has combined with others to subject us to a jurisdiction foreign to our Constitution, and unacknowledged by our laws; giving its Assent to their Acts of pretended Legislation.

It has obstructed the Administration of Justice, emboldened our enemies, and diminished our security, by refusing to treat terrorists as enemy combatants, instead treating our enemies, during a time of war, as civilians and providing them with all of the rights and privileges of a United States citizen.

It has refused to enact and uphold Laws, the most wholesome and necessary for the public good.

It has removed our Liberties, abolished our most valuable Laws, and altered fundamentally our Forms of Government.

It even now seeks to encroach upon the citizenry and to control every aspect of daily living through the creation of a perpetual state of manufactured crisis and its supposed solutions, all having the purpose of absolute rule over the citizens of these United States.

‘In every stage of these Oppressions We have Petitioned for Redress in the most humble terms.’ The Protests, Tea Parties, Marches on Washington, D.C., Town Hall Meetings, phone calls, emails and myriad other petitions and remonstrations of The People, have fallen on willfully deaf ears, and have not bent our elected representatives to the will of The People. Instead, ‘Our repeated Petitions have been answered only by repeated injury’; the voices of The People having been repeatedly and disdainfully ignored, cursed, demonized, and spat upon. And in the face of a clear majority of The People in opposition to policies and legislation, past, present, and proposed, that endanger our Liberty and Security, this government has chosen to redouble its efforts to enact policies and legislation that will bankrupt our nation, further erode our freedoms, and endanger our security, both at home and abroad. The People of these United States have patiently endured throughout, clinging to the faint hope of awaking one day to a repentant government; a government having forsaken its wayward thirst for power; a government striving with all its might to return to the Principles of our Nation's Founding. No longer able to cling to this hope we must declare, as our Founding Fathers declared: ‘A President and Congress whose

character is thus marked by every act which may define a Tyrant, are unfit to represent a free people.'

Tyranny and Liberty are mutually exclusive and by their very natures cannot coexist. We must, in the end, become all one thing or the other. Therefore, of necessity, we must either acquiesce, or succumb, as the case may be, to the heavy hand of Tyranny or grasp firmly and with all our might the mantle of Liberty.

'A house divided against itself cannot stand'. And if we are to be a United People, a Free People, we must work diligently and relentlessly to purge and then banish forever Tyranny, in all its forms and manifestations, from our land. We must no longer fear the disciples of Tyranny, who wield their cunningly devised weapons of war - political correctness, intimidation, verbal abuse, personal insults, manufactured crisis, and obfuscation - against the lovers of Liberty, in their attempts to silence the voices of Truth. We must speak the Truth boldly and without fear. We Must Remain Silent No Longer.

Our Nation's Founders fought to free themselves from Tyranny and to establish our great Republic. Our Nation's Founders fought a war of arms, shedding their precious blood, sweat and tears, so that they might Break the Bonds of Tyranny, and enjoy the sweet taste of Liberty. Many brave and honorable men and women have shed their blood, sweat, and tears since, in order to defend and preserve The People's Liberty and the Republic they held so dear; for their generation and for generations to follow. Today, the war between Tyranny and Liberty rages on, and we find ourselves once again engaged on the field of battle. Today, we wage this longstanding war on the battlefield of ideas, with the fervent hope that we might, through our peaceful nonviolent victory, avert the pending clash of arms and resulting shedding of blood, sweat, and tears that looms over our nation like a dark and ominous cloud. Today, we fight to defend and preserve our way of life; our Constitution; our Republic; our Liberty.

The choice of charting a new course leading to Liberty or continuing down the well-trodden path leading to enslavement and subjugation by a Tyrannical government, having been placed before The People, we hereby boldly declare our Independence from the numerous and endless insidious forms and manifestations of Tyranny, and our undying allegiance to the cause of Liberty.

'We, therefore, the People of the United States of America, appealing to the Supreme Judge of the world for the rectitude of our intentions, do, in the Name, and by the Authority granted to a Free People, solemnly publish and declare', with one resounding voice, that 'We The People of the United States are, and of Right ought to be Free' from a government rife with corruption, greed, and the undue influence of special interests; free from unconstitutional, intrusive and oppressive legislation, laws, codes, policies and mandates; free from out of control government spending; free from nonresponsive and irresponsible representation; free from burdensome taxation and nonsensical insidious tax codes; and free from the intrusiveness and oppression of BIG Government in general. Furthermore, we are resolved to once and for all Break the Bonds of Tyranny and throw off forever the chains of oppression that have been so long forged by Presidents and Congresses, past and present, having so nearly and completely bound us hand and foot, rendering us helpless beneath the heel of Tyranny.

That in the furtherance of securing our Liberty, we hereby commit ourselves to doing everything within our individual and collective power, short of violence or the taking up of arms against our

government or our countrymen, to cause the repeal of all unconstitutional, intrusive and oppressive legislation, laws, codes, and mandates, and to cause the enactment of Constitutional Amendments, which of necessity, are required in order to repair the former assaults against our Liberty, cure the excesses and corruption of the current President and Congress, place proper constraints upon The People's government, and return government to its proper and originally intended place of servitude to We The People, as established by Our Nation's Founders.

'And for the support of this Declaration, with a firm reliance on the protection of divine Providence, we mutually pledge to each other our Lives, our Fortunes and our Sacred Honor'.
